



MEETING MINUTES

MONDAY – AUGUST 12TH – 2019

Starting at approximately 8:30 PM called to order by President Jason Smith. This meeting followed the conclusion of the weekly summer league.

SMGA News

Many of you may or may not know, but currently the gold tees are not in GHIN so for anyone who plays from the gold tees, their scores get put in under the whites, and then they take that handicap back up to the golds. In the interest of fairness we voted to spend the funds to get the course recertified by the USGA and the gold tees added to GHIN. We asked about just adding the tees but the course rating expired in 2015 so in order for them to add gold tees, the course has to be recertified. We will work with the course to make sure any permanent modifications are made before we have them come out to do it. The cost is \$475 and the vote passed unanimously by those present.

In an effort to help out the golf course, we voted to spend approximately \$300 to buy matching flag sticks to replace the ones that were stolen recently. We ordered enough to replace what's missing and enough spares that should last us a while should anymore get broken or go missing. The golf course also ordered a matching set of flags.

We are expanding official MGA merchandise. In the next week or two, a web store will be set up that has MGA branded hats, polo shirts, pull overs, and golf towels. We will have samples of most of it available shortly to try on for sizing. We will post that information as it becomes available.
