## **Tournament News**

The MGA voted to start discussions with the Ladies Golf Association and Legends Management about a sand program to keep the bottles filled. Under the properly structured agreement, the Golf Associations will pay for the sand.



### **Course News**

Attendees were updated on a meeting of selected course members along with Jack Graham, Creed, and Staff. The meeting was held January 29<sup>th</sup> with members from the course, MGA, and LGA. The purpose of the meeting was to express concerns about the course condition and operating elements. The members of this committed met on several occasions to prepare a professional list of concerns with a cooperative approach to seek solutions and continuous improvements to the course and it's provided services. The top ten issues presented at this meeting were:

1. Irrigation system repairs for the back 9
2. Greens, Tee Boxes, and general course conditions
3. Replacement of pins and Tee Markers, along with frequent re-location of these items
4. Restrooms condition in the clubhouse and on the course
5. Maintenance
6. Creating and Adopt-A-Hole and Course Marshall Programs
7. Leadership, Staff Training, Customer Service, and Communication Programs
8. Parking lot and cart path repairs
9. Income improvement ideas and membership improvement ideas
10. Misc. including flag pole repair, Score card update, Course rules posted

Jack Graham presented a list of concerns that the group acknowledged. We collectively agreed to meet on an ongoing basis to improve these items and build a stronger relationship between the course and its members. The next meeting for the group will be February 19<sup>th</sup> to solidify action plans. The plans will be presented at the next MGA meeting.
